1. Welcome by Chair

4. Update of Building Regulations (Part F/L)

FETA submitted the response to the England consultation on the Future homes & Building Standard which is expected to be implemented from January 2025 onwards. Wales is expected later this year. Scotland timing to be confirmed.

5. Ventilation in schools/BB101 Review

The meeting requested we seek an update on this standard from Richard Daniels.

10. Proposal for group statistics report
